# **Vaughan Nash Community Competition 2023**

1st Vaughan Nash Silver Medal

2nd Vaughan Nash Bronze Medal

Nancy Macmillan Trophy (awarded to highest placed article outwith winner/runner-up)

President's choice (awarded to best in show)

# **Eligibility**

- **1** This competition is open to all Institutes but only one entry per Institute will be accepted. Two Institutes in the same Federation can submit a joint entry.
- 2 A minimum of four members must take part.
- **3** Only five items will be accepted. All articles must have been made by members in the period since the 2019 Handcrafts & Homeskills Conference.

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# **Important notes**

A maximum area approximately one square metre will be allowed to display the articles and the area will be covered in a royal blue drape. Please consider the size of articles for this space. Please enclose a photo of how you wish items to be displayed.

Each Institute is responsible for packing entries in boxes for onward transporting.

Headquarters will arrange the transport, unpacking and repacking of entries at the time of judging and displays are created by members of the H&H Committee.

All entries should be delivered to SWI headquarters, 42 Heriot Row, Edinburgh EH3 6ES by hand or post by June 1st 2023.

Judges will be appointed by the H&H Committee. Judges' decisions will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

**Please note:** No late entries will be accepted. SWI cannot be held responsible for an entry arriving damaged or late. Please consider whether you would like to arrange your own insurance cover for entries. If you wish your entry acknowledged, please send a stamped addressed envelope or email address.

#### How to enter

Please complete the entry form and email it to hello@theswi.org.uk marked 'Vaughan Nash 2023' by March 1st 2023. We will then send you the relevant tags by May 1st 2023 and you will send your entry (with tags attached) to SWI Headquarters, 42 Heriot Row, Edinburgh EH3 6ES no later than June 1st 2023.
